PAUSE stands for Practices and Approaches for Upskilling Educators. The project is an EU project funded under the Adult education sector of the Erasmus+ programme. A consortium of 8 organisations from 8 different European countries works together to create and exchange a database of good practices for improving the skills and competences of educators working with (vulnerable) adults.

First things to be done...

The upcoming 6 months will be dedicated to selecting practices that address people from disadvantaged backgrounds (migrants, Roma, refugees, asylum seekers) and the educators who work with them.
